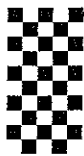

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of the within Order to Show Cause, the associated Unfair Labor Practice Charge, Charging Party's Certification and Memorandum in support of its application be served upon the above named Respondent by November 5, 2009; proof of service shall be filed with the Commission immediately thereafter;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Respondent file with the Commission's named designee by November 11, 2009, an original and two copies of its answering brief and any opposing affidavits or verified pleadings, together with proof of service of a copy on all other parties.
