RESOLUTION DELETING CAMDEN COUNTY POLICY & PROCEDURES NO. 3.0 "RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT"

WHEREAS, the County of Camden has adopted a Policy & Procedures Manual that provides for certain standards of operation by County employees; and

WHEREAS, Camden County Policy Number 3.0 requires that employees of the County of Camden be "bona fide" residents of the County; and

WHEREAS, the County of Camden has reviewed certain policies and determined that some policies and procedures need to be implemented, amended, updated or deleted to better serve the interests of efficient and effective governmental operations; and

WHEREAS, given the continued National economic situation and the overall continued decline in the real estate market, the Board of Chosen Freeholders has determined that enforcement of Policy 3.0 will place an undue burden upon valued Camden County employees and their families, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Freeholders must carefully balance the necessity for enforcing the policy with the need to safeguard and shield County employees from the current downturn in the real estate market, and

WHEREAS, the County previously issued a six month moratorium that was in effect from February 1, 2009 through August 1, 2009;

WHEREAS, an additional six month moratorium on enforcement of Policy 3.0 was then issued from August 1, 2009 through February 1, 2010; now therefore,
